Egg Weights & Sizes

\* indicates general sizes we encounter. These are not USDA sizes.

We sell ungraded eggs. This means that we do not sort our eggs by size. When you go to the grocery store you buy eggs by size: large, jumbo, medium, etc. However, when chickens begin to lay eggs for the first time, their eggs are quite small. To be included in our regular chicken egg dozens, we feel that the egg must meet or exceed 1.75 ounces (medium sized). These pullet (young chicken) eggs are safe to eat but do have a higher percentage of eggs without yolks and with blood spots. The chickens' bodies are still trying to figure out how to lay eggs so you would not expect them to be perfect. Since these eggs are much smaller than normal size chicken eggs, we do not feel right selling them at the same price. For that reason, we offer 18 count cartons of pullet eggs.
